Fuvahmulah island lies about 352 kilometers southwest of Velana International Airport (MLE), commonly referred to as Male Airport. Travel time via Domestic Flight Transfer typically takes around 1 hour and 25 minutes.

It's the sole destination where Tiger, Thresher, Silver Tip, White Tip, Gray Reef Sharks can be spotted year-round. Dos and Dont's for Diving with Tiger Sharks in Fuvahmulah




- 1. Do Not Feed: Under no circumstances should you attempt to feed Tiger Sharks or any other marine animals during your dive. Feeding disrupts their natural behavior and may lead to aggressive encounters.
- 2. Avoid Sudden Movements: Refrain from making sudden movements or loud noises that could startle or agitate the sharks. Maintain a calm and composed demeanor throughout your dive.
- 3. Do Not Approach Aggressively: Avoid approaching Tiger Sharks too closely or in an aggressive manner. Respect their space and allow them to move freely in their environment.
- 4. Do Not Touch: Resist the temptation to touch Tiger Sharks or any other marine life you encounter during your dive. Touching can cause stress to the animals and may provoke defensive behavior.
- 5. Refrain from Flash Photography: Flash photography can startle and disorient Tiger Sharks, so it's best to avoid using flash photography during your dive. Opt for natural light or underwater photography techniques that minimize disturbance.



- 1. Follow Expert Guidance: Always dive under the supervision of experienced guides who are familiar with the behavior of Tiger Sharks and know how to ensure a safe encounter.
- 2. Maintain Respectful Distance: Admire these majestic creatures from a respectful distance to avoid startling them or disrupting their natural habitat.
- 3. Remain Calm: Maintain a calm demeanor and steady movements underwater to minimize disturbances and promote a harmonious interaction.
- 4. Observe Wildlife Etiquette: Respect the marine environment and refrain from touching or chasing Tiger Sharks or any other marine life.
- 5. Stay Alert: Remain vigilant and attentive to your surroundings at all times to ensure your safety and the safety of others in your group.

HAMMERHEAD SHARK


September - December & March - May

ALL YEAR ROUND



ALL YEAR ROUND



March - May








6 double deluxe rooms available, guests can indulge in spacious comfort, whether on the ground floor or upper level, each adorned with a delightful balcony.


